Support services for that will include the delivery of prevention initiatives, raising awareness, delivery of targeted and direct support for children and young people at risk/victims of CSE. The service will be delivered by Young Peoples Service through Youth Works and will have 2 full time CSE Project Workers based in Calderdale.

**Targeted specialist support services project for parents/carers**

In May 2016 a support service started work with parents and carers of children and young people at high and medium risk/victims of CSE. The service is delivered by Pace – Parents Against Child Sexual Exploitation, a national charity specialised in working with parents and carers whose children are sexually exploited, it will work with up to 45 families in 12 months and has 1 full time Parent Liaison Officer based in Calderdale. The service also includes training professionals and developing a volunteer programme.
