A Community Response to Preventing Sexual Harm, by having a Proactive and Safe Approach by Effectively Supporting Sex Offenders in the Community

SUMMARY OF THE EVENT -

106,609 sexual offences were reported last year, the highest since national records began in 2002. There has been a 60% increase in reported child sexual abuse in the last five years. People convicted of sexual offences are living in, and returning to the community at all times. Understanding motivations for offending can assist professionals to work more effectively with them.

This awareness session enables participants to take a proactive and safe approach to effectively supporting sex offenders in the community, gain an understanding around typologies, risk management and to discuss how we can work together to prevent sexual harm.

NEW HEALTHY RELATIONSHIPS RESOURCES

WEBSITE TO LAUNCH IN JUNE 2018



The West Yorkshire Police and Crime Commissioner has provided innovation funding to develop an online resource library that all schools can access about Healthy Relationships.

A survey undertaken about existing resources showed 72% of schools said that recommended resources in one location with links to information that was not paper based alongside the opportunity to read other schools recommendations would be very helpful.

Calderdale Council has worked with both Primary and Secondary schools and partners to develop the new website that will be launched in June 2018. Schools have a critical role in protecting children and this website will pull all the resources available to them together in one place. It will enable schools to easily access catalogued external links to materials and resources based on topic, school age etc.

The website replaces a paper version of the resource list and will enable schools to also recommend and add new resources as well as provide feedback for other professionals to see.
